LISA WALKER • FOSTER YOUTH FEBRUARY ROCK HERO

No doubt you've seen Lisa Walker front and center... enthusiastically volunteering at many Rock events. She has been an integral part of the Jamaica crusade, Toys For Joy, and events as far back as the Miles Ahead crusade in Canada, and she serves with heart and a personality plus.

Lisa is a social worker with a big heart for children in need. When she came to the Rock she said she saw kids who needed love... and a big church with lots of people with love to pour out. That's how the "Step Up" ministry was born.

Children in the foster care system have been taken from their homes, sometimes because of parental abuse or neglect. Away from their mothers and fathers, these children lack consistency in their lives. Foster parents and social workers come and go, but a mentor can be someone who will always be there. Statistics show that when a foster child has a mentor, their grades are higher and they are less likely to get into trouble. Lisa says mentors change lives.
