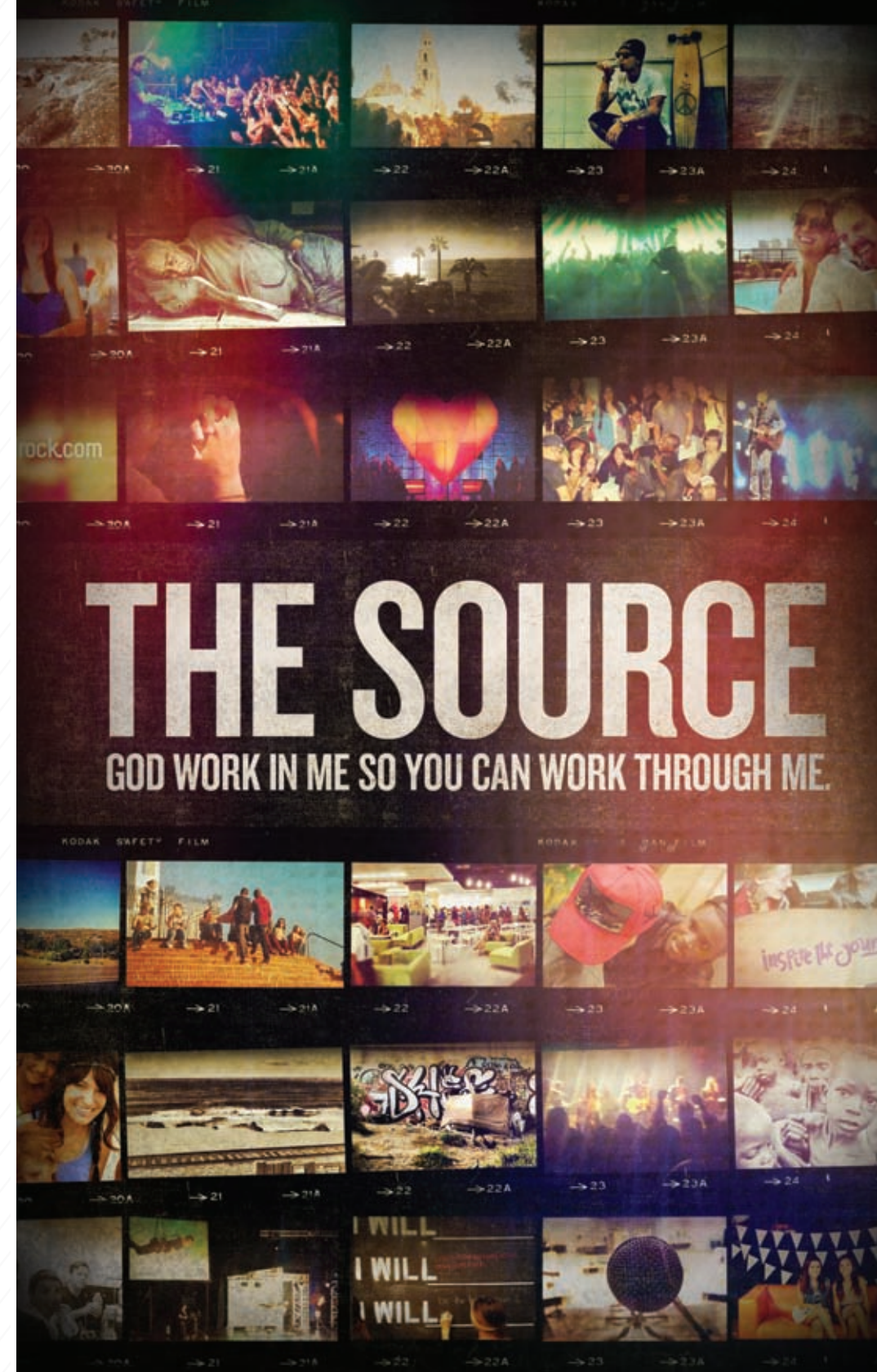

Where did you grow up? What was it like?

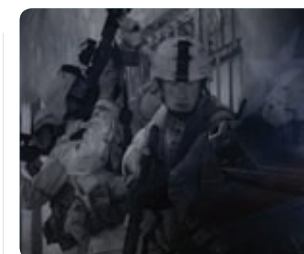
