



**Title:** The Throne of Grace

**Passage:** Hebrews 4

**Memory Verse:** "Could you not watch with me for one hour?" Matthew 26:40b

1. What were the "multitudes" doing in the following passages:  
**Matthew 15:29-30**  
**Mark 8:1-10**  
**Matthew 5:1-2**  
**Matthew 21:6-11**  
**Matthew 26:47**  
**Matthew 27:15-26**
2. Jesus called individuals out of crowds: Read **Luke 19:1-10**. Who did Jesus call out? Why? What was the result of their dinner engagement?
3. Read Hebrews 4:14-16 – When was the last time you visited the Throne of Grace? Take some time to do that now as a group.
4. When preparing to pray how does **Matthew 6:5-6** fit in?
5. What do you admire about the Lord? Go around have everybody share at least one aspect of the greatness of God that they love.
6. What are you thankful for? (Read **1 Chronicles 16:8-10** as an encouragement and **Romans 1:20-21** as a warning.)
7. **Psalm 46:10** introduces another aspect of prayer.
  - a. What does it add?
  - b. Why is it so hard to do this?
  - c. Share ways you have been successful.
8. When was the last time you heard God speak to you? What did he say? Did you write it down?
9. Why do we need to confess our sins? (Read **Psalm 51** and **1 John 1:9-10**.)
10. What is intercession?
11. How do we need to go about restoring a fallen brother? (**Galatians 6:1-5**)
