**TITLE:** Salvation, Simple as ABC

**MEMORY VERSE:** "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes." **Romans 1:16a**

### **SERMON REFLECTIONS**

1. Read **Genesis 3:6,7, and 21** - How did Adam attempt to "cover" himself? Why was that unsatisfactory to God? How did God "cover" Adam and Eve? Why was the shedding of blood necessary?
2. Read **Isaiah 9:6** and go around your Small Group and share personally how Jesus fulfills these attributes in your life. (Example - How is Jesus WONDERFUL to you?)
3. Go around your Small Group and read **Psalms 22** and **Isaiah 53** our loud. Make a mental note of all the ways Jesus fulfilled these prophecies. Remember they were written over seven hundred years before the birth of Jesus.

### **DAILY BIBLE READING**

4. Read and compare **2 Chronicles 16:9** and **2 Chronicles 25:1-2**. What does it mean to have a loyal heart? What does God provide for those whose hearts are loyal? What description are we given of Amaziah? What does this passage mean to you?

### **DIGGING DEEPER** - refer to your Stone Tablets sermon notes

5. How can you trust a God you have never seen? How can you prove that God exists?
6. How can God send good people to hell?
7. Did Jesus ever claim to be God, the Savior, or the Christ?

**HOMEWORK:** Be sure to take the survey to determine your personal style of evangelism. Also, keep your three people in earnest prayer.
