SERMON REFLECTIONS

This week we would like to **PRACTICE** so we can put into **PRACTICE** what we are learning.

Divide your Small Group up into three groups.

1. **Group number 1:** Share with everybody in your Small Group the “P” part of your testimony. (What was your **PROBLEM**?)
2. **Group number 2:** Share with everybody in your Small Group the “A” part of your testimony. (How and when did you find the **ANSWER**?)
3. **Group number 3:** Share with everybody in your Small Group the “S” part of your testimony. (How has the **SOLUTION** changed your life?)

DAILY READING

4. Read **Esther 4:13-14**. What lessons are there in this passage? Do you have a “for such a time as this” testimony?

DIGGING DEEPER

5. If confronted, how would you defend the Bible as being the **WORD** of God?
6. Share with your Group the last time you had the opportunity to share your faith. What were the results? How did it make you feel?
7. Read **Luke 5:27-32**. This method of evangelism is sometimes referred to as having a **MATTHEW** Party. Before our Evangelism series comes to an end, have your Small Group pray about what you can do – kind of like a lab. Maybe plan out your own **MATTHEW** Party?
