### SERMON REFLECTIONS

1. The big questions of life are: where did we come from, what is our purpose of being here, and where are we going? Our understanding of Genesis affects all of these questions. How does our understanding of Genesis affect our idea of where we came from? How does it affect our purpose for living? How do our origins affect our ethics? How does it affect our understanding of our future? (See sermon notes on "7 Conditions Beginning In Genesis To Be Restored In Revelation")
2. Why is a six-day creation important? Reflect on the sermon and take a moment to read *Stone Tablets*.
3. Define the concept of "Irreducible Complexity" – how does this concept point to a master designer? If this is true in nature, how can you apply it in your life?

### DAILY WALK

1. Read **Proverbs 25:11**. "*Words are easy to cast but difficult to reel in.*" Have your words been golden apples or crabapples? Think and pray about a "word fitly spoken" that you could share with the following: boss or co-worker; parent or teacher; son or daughter; spouse or friend – saved or unsaved. Take a moment to pray, then share with your Small Group what you intend to do this week. (By now, you should have an accountability partner in your Group to check up on you through the week!)
2. Read **Romans 1:8-15**. Let's now have a lab session. Let's pray together and pray for the same things Paul prayed for in this passage. (Let's impart some spiritual gifts, some encouragement, and some mutual faith).
3. Read **Romans 1:18-32**: What is the bad news in the Book of Romans? Now read **Romans 1:16-17** and share what the good news is.
