SERMON REFLECTIONS

1. What are some reasons God would challenge you to leave your comfort zone and walk by faith? (**Hebrews 11:6**) Share with the Group an area where He has challenged you, you were obedient, and He blessed you. (**Romans 8:28**) If you cannot remember a situation like this...why?
2. Who is discipling you? Are you discipling someone? **Matthew 28:16-20** is the great commission, not the great suggestion. Is your life a reflection if the Sea of Galilee or the Dead Sea?
3. Last week we talked about what you want your name to be. This week, think about what people think when they hear your name. (**Genesis 12:2**) Are you a blessing? What do you represent? Share with your accountability partner some ways that you need to represent Christ better in your life. *Be sure you are held accountable to these things.*

1. Why did Abraham have to go?

CLOSER WALK

1. **Acts 1:3** – What were some of the “infallible proofs” that Luke is referring to here? (see **1Cor. 15:1-11**)
2. **Acts 1:4-8** – Why did the disciples need to wait? How can we get “*dunamis*” power? Study **John 14-16** and list the job description of the Holy Spirit.
3. What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit? What was the results of Peter's being filled with the Holy Spirit – take a look at his “before and after” profile.
4. What are you “devoted” to? (Sports teams, television programs, magazines ...) Consider **Acts 2:42** – What are some of the ways you could become devoted to the things you find listed in this verse?
5. *For those who like to dig deeper ...* Many scholars consider the birthday of the church to be at the Feast of Pentecost. Dig a little and find the historical relevance of this Jewish feast. Start with **Lev. 23:15-22** and **Deut 16:16**. Compare closely **Exodus 19** and **Acts 2**.

HOMEWORK

Who are you learning from and who are you teaching? Seek the Lord this week and ask Him to show you who can mentor you, and who you should be discipling. (**1 Corinthians 11:1**)
