### Title: Knowing Gods Will Part II

**MEMORY VERSE:** Romans 12:1-2 - I beseech you therefore brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of god.

### SERMON REFLECTIONS

Miles discussed 6 ways that we can present our bodies as a living sacrifice in the sermon notes. Go over each one of them, and read the scriptures (Job 31:1, 1 Tim 2:8, Heb 12:1, Phil 4:6-8, Eph 4:29, Ezek 11:19). Are any of these areas something that you need to work on today?

### CLOSER WALK

When Paul witnessed, what was central and consistent in his message? (See Acts 24:15, Acts 26:8, Acts 9:22, Acts 17:32, and Romans 3:1-4,16. Are you keeping your witness simple and on target?

### PEBBLES PATHWAY – Early Childhood (2-3 yr olds) “The Good Samaritan”

Memory Verse “Love one another.” 1 John 4:7

What did the bad guys do to the Israelite? Did the priest stop to help the Israelite? Who does Jesus want us to love?

### PEBBLES PATHWAY – Early Childhood (4-5 yrs.) “The Prodigal Son”/“The Sorry Son”

Memory Verse “Let us love one another.” 1 John 4:7 (Check w/ your teacher on which story was taught this week)

The Prodigal Son: What did the younger son want from his father? What did the younger son do with all the money? Should we get jealous when God blesses someone else?

The Sorry Son: Which son asked his father for his money? What did he do when all the money was gone? Did the father forgive his son?

### PEBBLES PATHWAY – Elementary K-2 “The Healing of the Blind Man”

Memory Verse “...For I am the Lord who heals you.” Exodus 15:26

What did Jesus do to heal the man? What was the pool’s name that Jesus told the blind man to wash in?

### PEBBLES PATHWAY – Elementary 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> “The Covenant of Healing”

Memory Verse “...For I am the Lord who heals you.” Exodus 15:26

Sickness and disease have never been a part of God’s \_\_\_\_\_. How did Jesus pay for our healing?
