Title: What Does Wisdom Say? Part 3 – Purely Wise

MEMORY VERSE: Can a man take fire to his bosom, and his clothes not be burned? Proverbs 6:27

SERMON REFLECTIONS

1. In **1 Kings 11:1-13**, we read about Solomon turning his heart from God. Solomon was the wisest man on earth; how could this have happened? What specific command from God did Solomon ignore? Discuss how the sin of one generation can affect future generations. What ultimately happened to Solomon?
2. In the sermon, Miles described a gullible guy (**Prov 6:32, 7:6-9, 7:22, 26**) and a luscious lady (**Prov 7:10-21**). Does either of these describe you? As you discuss with your group, prayerfully consider your own life. If you realize that you are in one of these categories, spend some time in prayer and truly give it over to the Lord. (**1 Cor 6:18**) Have your accountability partner hold you accountable to change. (**James 5:16**)
3. We reviewed the consequences of sexual sin during the sermon. They are guaranteed to affect all areas of your life. Break into pairs, men with men and women with women, and ask each other the hard questions. Are you in sexual sin? Are you caught up in pornography? Are you secretly lusting after someone? What is your thought life like? Today is the day to change. Give it to the Lord and trust that he ALWAYS has a way out. Get wisdom (ladies - **Prov 31**, men - **Prov 4:1-9**), accountability (**Prov 27:17**), and a pure heart. (**Prov 4:23, 1 Jn 1:9**)

CLOSER WALK (1 Corinthians)

The problem: you did not get your way ... what you expected did not happen ... your feelings are hurt ... and you are disappointed with another. The test of life: can it be said that "(insert your name) suffers long and is kind..."? **1 Cor 13:4** Growth hurts! The standard for comparison: **1 Peter 2:21-23, Phil 2:3-4, and 1 Peter 3:8-9**

HOMEWORK

Spend some quality time in prayer over the things you've discussed in your Small Group time. Search for Scripture to confirm the things God may be teaching you and pray how He might use you to biblically confront one another.
