SERMON REFLECTIONS

1. What does Easter signify to you? Why is Easter so important to our Christian Faith? (**1 Cor 15:14, John 6:33-40**) What would be different if Mary Magdalene had found Jesus' body in the tomb? (**John 20**) How did Jesus prophesy his own Resurrection? (**Matt 20:19, Mark 9:9, 14:28, Luke 18:33, John 2:19-22**) Why is it important that Jesus was seen after His Resurrection? How many times was He seen? (**John 20:11-24, Mt 28:1-10, Lk 24:13-35, Mk 16:14-19, Jn 21:1-23, 1 Cor 15:6**) Does this give you joy, and peace? <http://christiananswers.net/dictionary/resurrectionofchrist.html>
2. In the sermon, Miles asked "When was Jesus at His best?" The answer is found in **John 21:15 - 19**, when Jesus said, "Follow me." Think about the different things that could be considered Jesus at His best. Is there anything that Jesus cannot forgive or heal? (**Mark 2:1-12**) Is there any reason today that you cannot come to God with any issue and ask Him to help you? (**Ps 48:14, Lk 1:79, Jn 16:13**) Share with your accountability partner an area of your life that you have not submitted (**James 4:7a**) to the Lord, and have them hold you accountable to give it to Him.

CLOSER WALK (1 Corinthians)

1. Discipline within the church: Can you find the sin (**1 Cor 5:1-2,11**) the discipline (**1 Cor 5:3,13**) the results (**2 Cor 2:3-8**)? Did everyone obey Paul (**2 Cor 2:6,9**) ?
2. Heart Issues: Connect the dots – (**2 Cor 3:2,3:18, 4:2, and 4:7**). In what order?
3. Ministry comes out of a guarantee (**2 Cor 5:5**), a goal (**2 Cor 5:7-10**), and a motive (**2 Cor 5:14**). Which leads to what ministry? **2 Cor 5:18-20**

When are you at your best? Jesus said, "Follow me." Spend some time in prayer this week and ask God to show you what you need to change, do, or stop doing in order to be at your best.
