SERMON REFLECTIONS

Ps 119:2 - *Blessed are those who keep His testimony, who seek Him with a whole heart!* What is a testimony? Why is a personal testimony so important? How can your personal testimonies about being a Christian have an affect on someone else's life today? (**Ex 34:29, 1 Kings 11:12, Ps 78:5**)

PEBBLES PATHWAY – Early Childhood (2-3 yrs.) “Adam & Eve”

Memory Verse: “Everything God made is good.” **Genesis 1:31** Who made the world? Did God make the first man and woman? Did God make you?

PEBBLES PATHWAY – Early Childhood (4-5 yrs.) “Jonah and the Whale”

Memory Verse: “Jesus said, “...I am with you always...” **Matthew 28:20** Who did God want Jonah to talk to? Did Jonah listen? What happened to Jonah when the men threw him out of the boat? How did he get out?

PEBBLES PATHWAY – Elementary “Long Live the King”

Memory Verse: “He that shall humble himself shall be exalted.” **Matthew 23:12b** What is the most important task of a leader? Who will leaders answer to as to how they use their powers? Who did God choose to be Israel’s first king?
