TITLE: The Adams Family Salvation, Part 2

MEMORY VERSE: And so it is written, "The first Adam became a living being." The last Adam gave a life giving spirit. **1 Corinthians 15:45**

SERMON REFLECTIONS

- 1) Do you understand your salvation? The sermon reflections from last week centered on the various aspects of our salvation, what it means, etc. It is VERY IMPORTANT that you understand all the aspects discussed last week.
- 2) The First Adam - Adam. (**Romans 5:12-14**) How was sin brought into the world through Adam? What does this mean for humanity? Is there any way to escape this sin?
- 3) The Second Adam - Jesus (**Romans 5:15-21**) How did Jesus take sin out of the world? What do you have to do to take advantage of what Jesus did for us? Explain atonement.
- 4) Which Adam's family do you belong to? Are you confident? Can you explain this to someone else in the group? Can you explain this to a non-believer?
- 5) Assuming you are a member of the Second Adam's family, Jesus, have you made a conscious decision to live your life according to the standards of the family? (**Rom 16:20, Rom 7:24-25, 1 Jn 5:4-5, 1 Cor 15:54-55**) Can you have anything to do with the other family? Are you entitled to all the benefits of being a part of Gods family through Jesus? What are they? (**Rev 3:5, Rev 21:7, Rev 3:12, Rev 2:17**) After thinking this through, what changes do you need to make in your life?

CLOSER WALK

- 1) Review **Hebrews 9**. What was the original purpose of the Ark of the Covenant? What are the symbolic features? What was inside? Where is it today? Does it have a future use?
- 2) Why was Jesus' blood better than that of sacrificed animals? Why did Jesus have to die?
- 3) What is the meaning of **Hebrews 10:7**? Where is the quotation found in **Hebrews 10:6-17** from?
- 4) Hebrews 10:24 Ask God to put someone on your heart that you can apply this verse to (and when you are stirring up, remember to do it in the spirit of **Galatians 6:1-8**).
- 5) Read **Hebrews 10:26-39** and **6:1-8**. What is the warning found in these passages?
