Exodus 3:11 - "But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?"

3. Discussion Questions

- 1) Considering Moses question of "Who am I", discuss the following.
 - a. In what ways do you think things you have accomplished, and how people treat you, form your sense of identity?
 - b. Discuss the following statement, "If our identity is not in the Lord, then it may be in money, cars, jobs, etc."
 - i. How do you change this?
 - c. Why must we understand our identification in God before we can step out in Faith?
 - d. God told Moses that He would be with him, what are the implications in this?
 - i. Discuss the following statement, "When God asks you to do something, it is all about Him, not you."
 - ii. If we understand that God will protect us, provide for us, pave the path for us, what is it that keeps us from stepping out in faith more?
- 2) Considering Moses question of , "Who are you", discuss the following.
 - a. Can you explain Gods answer of "I AM"?
 - b. If God is outside of time, and is all knowing, what implications does this have on your problems?
 - i. What should you do with a problem that you do not know how to deal with?
- 3) Discuss the following statement, "It is not about who you are, it is about whose you are!"
- 4) Discuss each of the attributes of God, as seen in His names.

Jehovah Nissi - The Lord is Conqueror (Exodus 17:15) or Jehovah my banner, the title given by Moses to the altar which he erected on the hill on the top of which he stood with uplifted hands while Israel prevailed over their enemies the Amalekites.

Jehovah Shalom- The Lord is Peace or Jehovah send peace (Judges 6:24), the name which Gideon gave to the altar he erected on the spot at Ophrah where the angel appeared to him.

Jehovah Shammah - Te Lord is there,(Ezekiel 48:35) the symbolical title given by Ezekiel to Jerusalem, which was seen by him in vision. It was a type of the gospel Church.

Jehovah Jireh - the Lord Provides (Genesis 22:14) Jehovah will see; i.e., will provide, the name given by Abraham to the scene of his offering up the ram which was caught in the thicket on Mount Moriah. The expression used in, "in the mount of the Lord it shall be seen," has been regarded as equivalent to the saying, "Man's extremity is God's opportunity."

El Shaddai - Almighty God

Jehovah Elyon - The lord God Most High

Jehovah Tsidqenu - the Lord is our righteousness, rendered in the Authorized Version, "The LORD our righteousness," a title given to the Messiah ([Jer 23:6](#), marg.), and also to Jerusalem ([33:16](#), marg.).

Jehovah Repheka - The Lord is Healer

Jehovah Elohim - the Lord is God.
