1. Talk about an accountability relationship you have had in the past. What aspect of the relationship was beneficial to you and what would you have done differently? _____

2. Is accountability important? is it enough to say that Jesus keeps you accountable? Why or why not (Proverbs 27:17)? _____

3. In the Sunday sermon, Pastor Miles discussed 5 characteristics of a successful accountability relationship. As you look at each one, share how you can apply them to your life. They are:
 - A. Keep each other accountable to respond to the leading of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:1-2). This is manifested by spending time in the Word and in prayer together (Matthew 26:36-46). _____

 - B. Keep each other accountable to represent a lifestyle of discipline, unselfishness and focus (Matthew 3:4). This is characterized by participating in fasting, service to others and an evangelistic lifestyle (1 Corinthians 9:24-27, 2 Timothy 2:1-5, 1 Samuel 14:1-3). _____

 - C. Keep each other accountable to receive repentance with love and understanding (Matthew 3:5-6). This is characterized by bearing each others burdens with love and compassion (James 5:16, Galatians 6:1-2). _____

 - D. Keep each other accountable to bear fruit worthy of repentance, faithfully rebuking hypocrisy and sinfulness in each others life (Matthew 3:7-12). This is characterized by confronting sin with love and boldness when necessary (Matthew 18:15, 2 Timothy 2:24-26). _____

 - E. Keep each other accountable to respect and honor the complete lordship of Christ (Matthew 3:13-17). Remember, you ultimately serve the Lord, not each other (1 Samuel 20). _____
