COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS — THE LIFE, PART ELEVEN

As we wrap up our study on “The LIFE” Pastor Miles, went over the acronym we are now utilizing the LIFE App., and how we can apply this properly in our own personal discipleship. Specifically in the portion title “Impacting Ministry” Pastor Miles identified four different types of people that should help us shape our Christian journey.

The following questions will simply provide a practical discussion of how we desire the direction of our discipleship to be. I challenge and encourage you to answer these questions together. By together, I mean, how as a group can we serve each other in growing closer to Jesus?

Study Questions:

1. Who have you defined as the “Barnabas” in your life? Who is the person that will mentor you in the faith? Some things to assist you in your search for a mentor should include:
 - Are they submitted to the Bible as the Word of God?
 - Are they following Jesus in a way that is contagious?
 - Do they have a mentor themselves that encourages them in their faith?
 - Do they express humility and the ability to be vulnerable before you as they encourage you in your faith?
2. Who have you defined as the “Silas” in your life? Who is the person that will come alongside you in your walk with Jesus and assist you in ministry opportunity? Some things to assist you in your search for ministry partner should include:
 - Do they have the same passions as you?
 - Is this someone that you trust? Can you confess sin and be held accountable to them?
 - Do you pray and study the Bible together?
 - Are you committed to the same church and the same vision to the church?
3. Who have you defined as the “Timothy” in your life? Who is the person that you can pour into so that they will increase in their walk with Jesus? Some things to assist you in your search for mentee should include:
 - Are they currently following Jesus?
 - Are they humble enough to grow and do they have a teachable spirit?
 - Are you humble enough to learn from them as well?
 - Do you give them “assignments” to assist them in their growth?
