Answer these questions and discuss in your group this week:

1. Discuss your thoughts about being 'wired' to one person only. Do you believe this is reasonable or is it an outdated way of thinking?
2. Have you ever felt enslaved to different sexual impulses and desires? Do you believe these desires and impulses are wrong according to God, or natural according to cultural standards? Please explain your view.
3. Read 1Cor.6:12-20 and discuss what the Apostle Paul has to say about sexual immorality. From his perspective, what do you feel he is trying to communicate?
4. Are there areas in your life that sexual immorality has damaged? Discuss with the group how you have pursued healing in those situations or ideas for healing and protection from that pain in the future.
