Video for the Web: Video Podcasting, Video Emails, Video content for our websites. Archiving/Cataloguing: Manage and organize all existing footage from the last 15 years of ministry. **External:** Television Show Capture: Leads and mobilizes team for live capture. Oversees live video switching for IMAG. Coordinates with Technical Director for lighting and scenic design for television. Television Show Post Production: Oversees process of editing and completing product. Produces and directs field work documentary pieces to support show topic. Produces broadcast quality product. Multi-site Venues: Create and distribute product to off-site video venues.
