Brief Description of Major Duties: The Weekend Service Art Director is responsible in coordination with the Creative Director for the overall look and feel of weekend services. The Weekend Service Art Director works under the direct supervision of the Creative Director. Collaborates with the Creative Director to create the look of the weekend services. The look included graphics used for scenic video and print. Creates environmental video for weekend services. Works closely with lighting/scenic director to coordinate and implement all environmental video for weekend services. Creates graphic design elements to support all post production projects from the weekend services. Presents final products to management for approval by agreed upon deadline and make any adjustments/changes as necessary. Coordinates with web master to facilitate necessary on line media. Creates, coordinates and/or incorporates graphic content into video production. Responsible for the coordination of and oversees all volunteer staff.

Qualifications & Requirements: Christ-centered behavior (treating people with dignity, respect, compassion and integrity at all times). A bachelor's degree in a related field is preferred but not required. Strong team player both accepting and giving direction. Ability to work well with timelines and short deadlines. Ability to work in a high volume environment while maintaining solid creativity and quality. Ability to communicate effectively to personnel, through outlines, story boards, etc. when necessary.
