Brief Description of Major Duties: The Multimedia Editor is responsible for leading the creative process of developing videos and other multimedia elements to enhance the message at services and special events in the church. This includes working closely with the Director of Production in generating the creative ideas, casting, selecting location, developing the overall feel of the video, and selecting the team to shoot/edit the video. Responsibilities range from conceptualization to final product. The incumbent will maintain all necessary records and documentation of inventory and media footage. The Multimedia Editor works under the direct supervision of the Director of Production. Involved in all relevant development related to promotions in regards to multimedia. Participate in department's budget management under the direction of the Director of Production. Assists Production staff with content and direction of video elements related to the Rock Church and its affiliates. Maintains a professional level of production for RockTV and all other in-service content, looking toward the future as it relates to television broadcast. Maintains creative control and direction of video projects from conceptualization to completion as assigned by the Director of Production. Works with the Coordinating Producer to help coordinate video shoots and edit dates for assigned projects to meet deadlines. Directs and assists (when necessary) the setting up of location equipment for assigned projects. Directs projects on location or on-set. As the director, has the final word on location or on-set. Presents final cut to management for approval by agreed upon deadline and makes any adjustments/changes as necessary. Helps in the conceptualizing process with the Director of Production and Worship Arts Pastor in the creation of media for weekend worship. Maintains a catalogued library of stock footage as a production resource as well as logs and archives all video projects. Continually researches and follows trends that are relevant to the Rock Church's demographic and keeping in line with the "Save. Equip. Send." philosophy. Responsible for maintaining inventory of production supplies; proactively requisitioning supplies as necessary. Creates, coordinates and/or incorporates relevant graphic content into video production. Coordinates with web master to facilitate necessary on-line media. Continually upgrades and advances the multimedia department to stay ahead of the trends.

Qualifications & Requirements: Christ-centered behavior (treating people with dignity, respect, compassion and integrity at all times). A bachelor's degree in a related field is preferred but not required. Strong team player both accepting and giving direction. Ability to work well with timelines and short deadlines. Ability to work in a high volume environment while maintaining solid creativity and quality. Ability to communicate effectively production vision to involved personnel, through outlines, story boards, etc. when necessary. Ability to use non-linear video editing systems (such as Final Cut Pro) while working in a high volume deadline oriented environment. Understanding of motion and still graphic programs such as Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, After Effects, Macromedia Flash, Apple Motion, DVD Studio Pro and other related programs. Ability to use still and video production equipment to include: audio, video and lighting. Self-motivated and flexible. Strong organizational skills. Excellent interpersonal communication skills. Ability to interact with other ministry leaders and or personnel in a positive and customer focused manner. Experience in conflict resolution. Excellent verbal and written communication skills. Legible writing skills. Familiarity with Apple Mac OS X operating system. Ability to work independently or in a team-oriented environment. Ability to recognize and maintain confidentiality as appropriate.

Maintains a Class C driver's license and an acceptable driving record (in accordance with the employee's auto insurance carrier and less than two DMV points on driving record). Regular involvement in the Rock Church activities and events. Signed acknowledgement of the Rock Church Statement of Faith. Adheres to policies and procedures as stated in the Rock Church employee handbook. Must be a member of the Rock Church.
