Brief Description of Major Duties: The Senior Graphic Designer is responsible for creating or directing the design layouts for all materials that go to print in association with the Rock Church and/or Miles Ahead Ministries. Reports to the Director of Communications and Marketing. Uses current design technology to create and prepare graphics for use by various media to explain or adorn printed or spoken word. Studies layouts, sketches of proposed illustrations and related materials to become familiar with assignment. Determines style, technique and medium best suited to produce desired effects and conform with reproduction requirements, or receives specific instruction regarding these variables. Formulates concept and renders illustration and detail from models, sketches, memory and imagination. Discusses designs at various stages of completion and makes changes as necessary. Ensures all print materials are in compliance with Rock standards and submits all work to the Communication Coordinator for review and approval. Compiles and maintains a graphics or photographic library and/or maintains digital records.

Qualifications & Requirements: Christ-centered behavior, i.e., treating people with dignity, respect, compassion and integrity at all times. Bachelor's Degree in graphic design or a related field preferred but not required. Must have at least 3-5 years experience in graphic design. Must have high accuracy, attention to detail and analytical skills. Strong communication skills Proficient in PhotoShop, Illustrator and InDesign. Must have strong organizational skills and the ability to execute multiple projects simultaneously. Ability to complete projects with tight/short deadlines. Familiar with HTML/CSS and Flash. Must be knowledgeable for Pre-Press. Solid understanding of interactive design principles, usability and online branding issues. Regular involvement in the Rock Church activities and events. Signed acknowledgement of the Rock Church Statement of Faith. Adheres to policies and procedures as stated in the Rock Church employee handbook. Member of the Rock Church.
