God created: light and water, heavens and sky, land and seas, sun, moon and stars, land animals, creeping things, and man.

Fossil record: skeletal evidence provided by the bones left behind by animals of the past.

Transitional forms: fossil evidence, which represents life forms between existing species.

Punctuated equilibrium: states that a vast majority of evolutionary changes in the history of life must have taken place in small populations and occurred so rapidly that there were not enough organisms or enough time for the transitional fossils to be preserved. This is an alternative to Darwin's slow evolutionary process due to lack of evidence.

3. Man was given the ability to be holy and shine like Him.

- Holy:
 - Dedicated, used for God, set aside for a single purpose, which is to glorify God.
 - Separated from that which is bad; connected to that which is good.
- Humans have the exclusive ability, opportunity and responsibility to represent the heart of God.
