



## Genesis: The Book of Beginnings

### Genesis 1-2

There are a total of 66 books in the Bible: 39 OT, 27 NT

The first five books are called the Torah or Pentateuch: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy.

What \_\_\_\_\_ **began** in Genesis? Creation of all material things, life, marriage and family, sin, death, plan of salvation, etc...

Who \_\_\_\_\_ **began** everything? (Genesis 1:1) In the beginning Elohim! Plural form of God. (Genesis 1:26) "Us" and "Our"

How \_\_\_\_\_ did God **begin** things? (Genesis 1:1) God 'Bara' Something created from nothing. God's original design and original intent. God is the uncreated creator. The scientific Principles that apply to creation do not apply to creator

Why \_\_\_\_\_ did it all **begin**? (Genesis 1:26-31) For man to walk with God and have dominion over creation

What \_\_\_\_\_ destroyed \_\_\_\_\_ the plan? (Genesis 3) Man sinned

What will \_\_\_\_\_ restore \_\_\_\_\_ it? God's plan of salvation: The Bible story

What will it look like? (Revelation 21:1-7) There will be no more: tears, death, sorrow, crying, or pain

**That which began in Genesis \_\_\_\_\_ will be completed in Revelation \_\_\_\_\_.**
