

## Salvation in the Days of Noah Genesis 7-9 April 18, 2004

A. God <u>called</u> godly people to serve a godly purpose . (Genesis 7)
<u>Eight</u> humans were <i>called</i> into the ark. (Genesis 7:1, 7, & 13)
Both <u>unclean</u> and clean animals were <i>called</i> into the ark (Genesis 7:2-3,8)
40 days of rain and <u>150</u> days of flooding were <i>called</i> onto the earth. (Genesis 7:4,24)
B. God <u>remembered</u> His salvation intentions. (Genesis 8)
God's promised <u>deliverance</u> from the flood is <i>remembered</i> . (Genesis 8:16-19)
Man remembers worship as his first <u>priority</u> . (Genesis 8:20)
God <i>remembers</i> His <u>affection</u> for mankind and man's worship. (Genesis 8:21)
C. God <u>blessed</u> Noah's family with a covenant. (Genesis 9)
Noah's family is <i>blessed</i> with authority to subdue and <u>multiply.</u> (Genesis 9:1-2)
Mankind is <i>blessed</i> with an expanded <u>diet.</u> (Genesis 9:3)
Mankind is <i>blessed</i> with a <u>rainbow</u> as a sign. (Genesis 9:11-16)
