### Accountability relationships must be with people who can faithfully:

Participate in fasting, service to others and an evangelistic \_\_\_\_\_.
3. keep each other accountable to \_\_\_\_\_ repentance with love and understanding. (v.5-6)  
Bear one another's \_\_\_\_\_ with love and compassion.
4. keep each other accountable to bear fruit worthy of repentance, faithfully \_\_\_\_\_ hypocrisy and sinfulness in each other's life. (v.7-12)  
When necessary, \_\_\_\_\_ sin with love and boldness.
5. keep each other accountable to \_\_\_\_\_ and honor the complete Lordship of Christ. (v.13-17)
