The Rock's Salvation ARMY is a group of people trained and armed to fight for the souls of unbelievers. Accountability in our training is the best way to maximize the effectiveness of the ARMY.

Accountability relationship **R **M** **Y****

Accountability relationships must be with people who can faithfully:

1. keep each other accountable to respond to the leading of the Holy Spirit. (v.1-2)
Spend regular time in the Word and prayer together.
2. keep each other accountable to represent a lifestyle discipline, unselfishness and focus. (v.4)
Participate in fasting, service to others and an evangelistic lifestyle.
3. keep each other accountable to receive repentance with love and understanding. (v.5-6)
Bear one another's burdens with love and compassion.
4. keep each other accountable to bear fruit worthy of repentance, faithfully rebuking hypocrisy and sinfulness in each other's life. (v.7-12)
When necessary, confront sin with love and boldness.
5. Keep each other accountable to respect and honor the complete Lordship of Christ. (v.13-17)
Remember that you both ultimately serve the Lord and not each other.
