Jesus claimed His own deity by:

1. **Exercising supernatural power through miracles.** *John 5:8*
Search the gospels for Jesus’ miracles and the periodic lesson taught after them.
2. **Claiming authority over the LAW.** *John 5:9*
Search the gospels for incidences that Jesus proclaims His Word as the ultimate authority over life and death.
3. **Exercising spiritual authority only assigned to God.** *John 5:14*
Search the gospels for incidences of Jesus exercising heavenly authority.
4. **Jesus gave Himself titles that made Him equal to God.** *John 5:17-18*
Search the gospels for the titles that Jesus gave Himself, especially referring to God as His Father.
5. **Jesus claimed to have authority over things in heaven.** *John 5:22*
Search the gospels for incidences claiming to have His own glory, angels, throne and authority in heaven.
6. **Jesus accepted worship which was only assigned to God.** *John 5:23*
Search the gospels for incidences of Jesus accepting worship or honor.
7. **Jesus made after life promises that only God can keep.** *John 5:24*
Search the gospels for incidences of Jesus claiming to do anything for anyone after He died.

Homework: Read all four gospels over the next month, 3 chapters per day, searching for Jesus’ claims.

Search the gospels for incidences of Jesus claiming to do anything for anyone after He died.

Homework: Read all four gospels over the next month, 3 chapters per day, searching for Jesus’ claims.
