Can you envision dreaming the impossible for your life?
 - If yes, then respond by developing and pursuing a plan to achieve that dream.
- 4. Transformation faith responds to Jesus' call**, even from the grave. Mark 5:40-43
Can you envision your love and service being requested by God Himself?
 - If yes, then respond to the call of Christ on your life and follow Him.
