Leviticus Review

Genesis –Book of beginnings.

Exodus is about the Exit from Egypt.

Leviticus – Laws Pertaining to the Levitical Priests - LP, LP

Levi **3rd** son of Jacob, Leviticus **3rd** book, Levi had **3** sons.

The descendants of Levi were the Levites.

The key word(s) – Holy or Holiness.

Leviticus is a book in the OT that taught Israel how to be Holy.

Aaron was the bother of Moses. **Exodus 28:1**

Levites were descendants of Levi. **Genesis 46:11, Exodus 6:16**

The High Priest was Aaron – head referee. **Exodus 28:2**

Priests were sons of Aaron – the referees. **Exodus 28:1**

Levites serve the Priests as caretakers of the sanctuary - grounds keepers. **Numbers 3:32**

The Priests served the High Priest. **Exodus 28:1-2**

The Israelites are the players in the game.

Two Major “W” Divisions - 10 Commandment Model

1. How to Worship God? Blood sacrifice is required.
2. How to Walk with God? Obedience to the Law is required.

Three Holiness Applications

1. God is Holy, which means that He is to be respected as our one and only Savior. For the Israelites, He was the God who saved them from slavery in Egypt. **Exodus 19:2**
2. The Israelites were to be Holy as His people. This teaches us that we are to be set apart for the divine purpose of representing God in the world. **Exodus 19:2**
3. God made the Israelites holy and He alone taught them the boundaries for holiness. This teaches us that He alone can purify us from our sin. **Exodus 20:9**

The Law

The Law was to define the boundaries of relationship with a Holy God.

Old Testament Law is clarified in the New Testament by Jesus and other New Testament authors.

The Law acts as a tutor by pointing to Jesus' teachings.

No one can be justified by the Law, only by faith. **Romans 3:20, Galatians 3:24-25**

Jesus fulfilled the Law and taught its spiritual application for our lives.

Jesus can be seen in the Israelites most holy day- the Day of Atonement.

Aaron was the first High Priest - Jesus was the Great High Priest. **Hebrews 4:14-16**

Atonement means to cover over – Their sins were covered over.

Only the High Priest could enter the Holy Place and perform the ceremony – only Jesus can approach God on our behalf. **Hebrews 9:11-14**

The high priest needed to first be forgiven – Jesus did not need to be forgiven because Jesus was sinless. **Hebrews 4:15**

Aaron offered the blood of animals yearly – Jesus offered His own blood only once. **Hebrews 9:27-28**

Aaron, the high priest transferred the sins of the people unto a goat – Jesus took our sins upon Himself. **2 Corinthians 5:21**

Two goats were used, one died and one carried sins into the wilderness - Jesus both died and carried away our sins. **2 Corinthians 5:21, Psalm 103:12**
