A name is an indication of His nature, character, reputation, and identity.

Hallow: to make holy

Elohim, plural of El. **Genesis 1:1** To be strong, powerful, mighty. Something (or someone) that is worshiped.

Yahweh - **Exodus 3** - I Am Who I Am

Ruach - air in motion, breathe, spirit

Ruach Elohim - Spirit of God

1. God hallows His own name by consistently, without fail, and completely fulfilling the meaning of His name.

The Spirit of God is:

Omnipresent **Psalm 139:7-10**; Omniscient **2 Corinthians 2:10-12**; Omnipotent **Genesis 1:2, Job 33:4**; Eternal **Hebrews 9:14**.

He is called:

The Spirit of God **1 John 4:2, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 1 Corinthians 2:10**; Spirit of Christ **1 Peter 1:11**; Holy Spirit, Hagios **Matthew 28:19-20, 2 Corinthians 13:14**; The Invisible Man, a 'He' **John 16:7-14**.

He:

Lives in you **John 14:17**; has a mind **Romans 8:27**; has a will **1 Corinthians 12:11**; loves you **Romans 15:30**; speaks **John 16:13, Acts 8:29**; speaks with a small, still voice **1 Kings 19:12**; groans, **Romans 8:26**; reminds us what Jesus said **John 14:26**; leads us into truth.

**C:** Pray for Communion with Yahweh Elohim.

Pray for Kingdom food. **Psalm 51:10-11, Psalm 16:11**

Dear Ruach Elohim, please bless me with Your presence and the spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ (strength, wisdom, vision, faith) to faithfully obey You today.

*And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. Matthew 6:12*

**I:** Intercede for other people.

Pray to have Kingdom of God relationships. **Matthew 5:44**

**P:** Petition for power.

Pray to exercise Kingdom of Ruach Elohim power. **Ephesians 6:10-13, 1 Corinthians 10:13**

*For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen. Matthew 6:13b*

**A:** Admiration and Praise; or Appreciate with praise.
