The medical outreach team attracted national press coverage as people from all over the region were treated and given needed prescriptions.

The Holy Spirit moved mightily in the lives of the 350 pastors that traveled for up to two days to receive encouragement in the word of God and ministry training at the Pastoral Training conference. Children flocked to play games and hear the gospel at the children's outreach, and God brought many souls to salvation during the team's visit to the Conakry Prison. We rejoice in having seen souls brought from death to life, hearts revived and practical solutions provided to meet practical needs for the Guinea community!
