A Do Something Disciple - A person with a disciplined pursuit of the heart of the Father, a heart being perfected in love for God and people.

D12: Avoids that which is displeasing to God.

H – Holiness **E** – Evangelism **A** – Appreciation **R** – Relationships **T** – Thoughts

Sermon Application:

- Do all that you can to relentlessly disciple those around you.
- Make the sacrifices necessary to be a disciple.
- Be distinct and separate to show off Jesus in your surroundings.
- Identify areas in your life that you are enslaved too.

Sermon Application Prayer: **ASK** God for His heart:

- Assess the condition of your heart. *Our heart changes moment-to-moment.*
- Search Scripture for the conviction of God’s heart. *God’s conviction is consistent.*
- Knit your heart with God. *A deliberate and constant surrender.*

Weekly Memory Verse: Leviticus 20:7 (NKJV) “*Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am the LORD your God.*”

Monthly Memory Verse: Leviticus 20:7 (NKJV) “*Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am the LORD your God.*”

On Sunday, our youth pastors delivered messages on discipleship. They focused on various chapters and versus from Leviticus. These include the following texts: **Leviticus 16:16-17; 17:11; 19:1-4; 20:13.** In your rGroup choose one of these chapters to read in the group and discuss what stood out.

Next, discuss the following questions in your rGroup:

- Do you believe that you are doing all you can to relentlessly disciple those around you? Why or Why not?
- What makes you distinct and separate to show off Jesus in your surroundings?

How Is Your Heart?

Question: Can you identify areas in your life that you are enslaved by? (Examples: lust, stealing, lying, etc.) List those things and boldly surrender them to God.

How Are You Pursuing God's HEART?

Being a disciple requires sacrifice. What have you sacrificed to be a disciple of God? What do you need to sacrifice to take steps forward in your discipleship journey?

NEXT STEPS:

Ask everyone in the group to meditate on and memorize the monthly verse for February by the end of the month. Encourage the group attendees to be prepared to share the scripture by the end of the month in the group.
