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**Brief Description of Major Duties:** The Database Developer's role is to strategically design and implement databases across the organization, while ensuring high levels of data availability. This individual is also responsible for defining standards and models for database architectures. The Database Developer will in addition evaluate and select all technology components, such as software, hardware, and networking capabilities, for database management systems and applications. The typical day for a database developer will involve working with computers, analyzing, developing, and implementing systems. Incumbent will spend some of each day with others, answering questions, explaining how the systems work, and troubleshooting problems with existing systems. Developer will work under the moderate to general supervision of the Information Technology Director. Define system requirements by consulting administrators and system users about the types of information needed. Determine how data should be organized, who should have access to different data and how it should be displayed. Develop data model describing data elements and how they are used. Reviews, evaluates, designs, implements and maintains company databases. Write manuals that explain database's function. Consult with others to assess the system performance and make modifications as required. Modify existing databases, as user needs change. Find faults in programs. Prepare reports on databases. Customize databases for specific needs. Train users and provide technical support.

Customer Service oriented mindset with pleasant, professional personality and appearance. College degree in computer related field. Two or more years experience with computer and network support. Strong data analysis and data modeling skills are required, data warehouse experience is desired. Experience in MySQL, PHP, Active Server Pages, and Access. Ability to meet project deadlines. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, employees and service representatives. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing. Ability to work well under short deadlines, handle multiple priorities, recognize and respond to urgent requests, and quickly adjust to changing priorities. Self-motivated and flexible in nature to handle other duties and special projects as needed. Regular involvement in the Rock Church activities and events. Signed acknowledgement of the Rock Church Statement of Faith. Adheres to policies and procedures as stated in the Rock employee handbook. Member of the Rock Church (or willing to transfer membership to the Rock Church).
