Japheth is the father of 14 nations. The sons of Japheth were: Gomer (Turkey, France, Spain, Wales,) Magog (Romania, Ukraine), Madai (Iran, India), Javan (Greece), Tubal (Russia), Meshech (Russia), and Tiras (Yugoslavia). *Gen 10:2*

Ham is the father of 30 nations. The sons of Ham were: Cush (Ethiopia), Mizraim (Egypt), Put (Libya), and Canaan (Palestine, Israel, Jordan). *Gen 10:6*

Shem is the father of 26 Nations. The sons of Shem were: Elam (Persia), Asshur (Assyria), Arphaxad (Chaldea), Lud (Turkey), and Aram (Syria). *Gen 10:22*
