The Beginning

Genesis – Book of beginnings. Exodus is about the exit from Egypt.
Leviticus - Laws pertaining to the Levitical Priests – LP, LP
Levi 3rd son of Jacob, Leviticus 3rd book, Levi had 3 sons.
The descendants of Levi were the Levites.

Holified

One Key Word – Holiness.
God was Holy, we are to be Holy and God makes us holy.
Holy means that we are to be set apart for a divine purpose. **Exodus 19:2**
50+ times “The Lord said to Moses” and “I am the Lord, I am holy.”

The Priesthood

Leviticus is an OT book about holiness.
Aaron was the brother of Moses. **Exodus 28:1**
Levites were descendants of Levi. **Genesis 46:11, Exodus 6:16**
The High Priest was Aaron – head referee. **Exodus 28:2**
Priests were sons of Aaron – the referees. **Exodus 28:1**
Levites serve the priests as caretakers of the sanctuary - grounds keepers.
Numbers 3:32
The priests served the High Priest. **Exodus 28:1-2**
The Israelites are the players in the game.
The priests were called out of the crowd – cleansed and purified. **Exodus 8:1-5**
The priests were clothed with righteousness and consecrated with anointing oil.
Exodus 8:1-30

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. 1 Peter 2:9-10

Two Major “W” Divisions - 10 Commandment Model

1. How to Worship God- Blood sacrifice is required.
2. How to Walk with God- Obedience to the Law is required.

Offering

Offering means ‘that which brings near.’
Offerings were selected according to God’s standards. **Leviticus 1:3**
The offerings sacrificed requires the worshipper’s full participation.

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Continued

The Old Testament is the foundation for the New Testament because it points to Jesus.

The Law acts as tutor by pointing to Jesus’ teachings. **Galatians 3:24-25**
Jesus fulfilled the Law and taught its spiritual application for our lives.
No one can be justified by the Law, only by faith. **Romans 3:20, Galatians 3:24-25**

Israel’s 7 festivals pointed to Jesus

Seven is the number of spiritual completeness and eight means super-abundance.

1. Passover – Jesus, our Passover lamb, died for our sin. **Leviticus 23:5-6, 1 Corinthians 5:6-8**
2. Feast of Unleavened Bread – Jesus removes the leaven, or impurity, from our hearts. **Leviticus 23:5-6, 1 Corinthians 5:6-8**
3. First Fruits – Christ as our first fruit is a deposit on our resurrection. **Leviticus 23:9, 1 Corinthians 15:20-23**
4. Pentecost – On the New Testament Pentecost, Jesus sent the Holy Spirit. **Leviticus 23:15, Acts 2:41, Exodus 32:27-29**
5. Trumpet - With the sound of a trumpet, Jesus will call us to Himself. **Leviticus 23:24**
6. Day of Atonement – Jesus, our Great High Priest, covers over our sins. **Leviticus 23:27, Hebrews 4:14**
7. Tabernacles – points to the eternal dwelling in heaven. **Leviticus 23:33-43**

The year of Jubilee represents eternal rest and the complete forgiveness of all debt.

The Great High Priest

Jesus is seen in their most holy day- the Day of Atonement.
Aaron was the first High Priest - Jesus was the Great High Priest.
Hebrews 4:14-16

Atonement means to cover over – their sins were covered over.

Only the High Priest could enter the Holy Place and perform the ceremony - only Jesus can approach God on our behalf. Hebrews 9:11-14

The High Priest needed to first be forgiven – Jesus did not need to be forgiven because Jesus was sinless. **Hebrews 4:15**

Aaron offered the blood of animals yearly – Jesus offered His own blood only once. **Hebrews 9:27-28**

Aaron, the High Priest, transferred the sins of the people onto a goat. Jesus took our sins upon Himself. **2 Corinthians 5:21**
