Bring this with you to small group this week.

1. Why do we find the drivers seat so attractive? Why do we crave that position? What's difficult about letting someone else drive?

2. In **Luke 8:40-48** we find a model for surrendering control and acting on faith alone. Read this passage together. In what way did this woman put Jesus in complete control of her life? In what way is she a model of what it means to surrender control to Jesus?

3. This woman had faith without knowing the end of the story. You may be in the middle of your story and are fearful about how it may end. What can you learn from the example of this woman?

4. Jonah was a man God designated for a particular job. He was "driving" Jonah to Nineveh when Jonah tried to get off the bus. Read **Jonah 1**. What did Jonah do instead of heading God's direction? Why do you think Jonah was able to sleep through such a violent storm?

5. What areas in your life do you need to surrender control? What encouragement do you find in **Matthew 6:25-34**?
